Lupe Morfin - Oral Re: Laws and rules have changed and people need to fight for rights and integrity in voting; registration with Real ID should be required and only citizens should be allowed to vote; requested to look at the inhumane conditions at the Registrar of Voters warehouses

Brigitte - Oral Re: Quoted Tupac Shakur; Trump is going to prove the election was stolen; document and public comments provided at 5/24/22 Board meeting; treatment of seniors and desecration of his mother; update regarding Klubnikin case; County Counsel violated subpoena rules and lawyers engage in fraud

John W. Spring - Oral Re: Memories of his wife who passed in 2021; October 19th is America's real independence day; sent analytical report to President John F. Kennedy regarding US Naval blockade of Cuba; approached by agent of Defense Intelligence Agency in 1961

Elizabeth Rios - Oral Re: County should not allow Social Services Agency to seize children from parents without a warrant; children were removed after disciplining her teenage daughter by taking her cell phone away which is not abuse; hearing on October 29th and requested Board return her children and investigate matter

Toni Taloa - Oral Re: Home care provider for her sister; In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) wage increases allowed purchase of daily essentials that she was unable to previously provide

Gloria - Oral Re: Home care provider for her mother; In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) benefits and wage increases for United Domestic Workers of America (UDW) are life changing; insurance benefits helped her with her health condition and to continue caring for her mom

Alberta Martinez - Oral Re: In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) provider for 10 years; lost her husband and IHSS benefits helped cover funeral and other expenses during very difficult times

Ilya Tsegin - Oral Re: Demands resignation of Chairman Wagner and revocation of his law license; Board misrepresents elected officials who are corrupted in Orange County such as judges and County officials; suppressing constitutional free speech

[Nick Kolev - Oral Re: Reported felony committed by Carlotta Serna, Chief Legal Counsel for Child Support](#) Services who says he owes child support money to the State disbursement unit; passport renewal is blocked

Cheryl - Oral Re: Problems with voter rolls in primary election; voter rolls are not accurate as required by the National Voter Registration Act of 1993; Supervisor Sarmiento's absence from public comments; had no intentions of disparaging Supervisor's son

Kate - Oral Re: 2021 recall, 2022 election and the 2024 primary were fraudulent; could save money and be better if the Board of Supervisors were closed down, removed County Executive Officer and County Counsels salaries and bomb building (CAN); Board needs to take care of the fundamental right provided by the almighty GOD in the Constitution of the United States, right to vote and select representatives from cities to the federal government; need to clean voter rolls

Roseann - Oral Re: Democracy is majority rule system and clarifying we are not a democracy, we are a constitutional republic; Board has the responsibility not to certify elections that violate the law; certification of the 2024 election; cease and desist letter regarding certification of election; nothing has been done to cleanup voter rolls; voting system needs to be auditable; need back-up voting system for power outages

Lisa H - Oral Re: Volunteers for the United Sovereign Americans (USA) read into the public record their resolution for a legally valid 2024 general election at a previous Board meeting; USA analysis of 2022 election indicates it was invalid and Shirley Webber served with complaint

Eileen McDermott - Oral Re: Provided information for informed voters in 2024; quit shutting the public from speaking and listen; names of prominent people in government who are married to prominent people in the media which proves they are all connected and it is all rigged; Kamala Harris' husband was Executive at DLA Piper and in charge of Clinton Foundation audit

Bryan Kaye - Oral Re: Board interaction with public during Board meetings; additional speaker time provided to one speaker; freedom of speech and silencing the public

Mary - Oral Re: Waste of money sending election materials in the mail; people can register to vote without ID and without any kind of verification, voter rolls are inaccurate, votes can be changed electronically on uncertified equipment; no audit control and rules are not followed; provided list of items not required by hand counting of ballots
