Jose Guevara - Oral re: Read letter from Congressman Lou Correa regarding extensive wait times for veterans

obtaining services through the Orange County Veterans Service Office; requested the Board take action to resolve wait times and asked to advise Congressman Lou Correa's office if they can be of assistance

Ilya Tseglin - Oral re: Tseglin family and Michael Klubnikin have been attending Board Meetings for seven years; necessary changes in government are ignored; requested the Board stop criminal enterprise throughout the County and pursue justice, rules of law and the County constitution

Gene James - Oral re: City of San Clemente resident; Catholic worker settlement and homeless population problem in the City of San Clemente; requested the County and Chairwoman Bartlett conduct a Town Hall meeting in the City of San Clemente to explain the impacts the settlement will have on the residents, discuss options and what the citizens and City Council can do to be a part of the solution; asked the Board to consider how permanent supportive housing for the homeless will alter the neighborhoods of San Clemente

Rick Loeffler - Oral re: City of San Clemente resident; emergency in the City of San Clemente with communities under siege, homeless population and health and safety issues; County has not provided a shelter for the homeless and Cities do not have the resources to provide shelters for the homeless; U.S. 9th Circuit Court of Appeals' ruling in Martin v. City of Boise

Michelle Brooks - Oral re: City of San Clemente resident; homeless problem in the City of San Clemente was caused by the County of Orange and needs to be addressed; permanent supportive housing will not prevent homelessness; need to provide drug addiction and mental health assistance to the homeless; story of Jane

Dee Coleman - Oral re: City of San Clemente resident and business owner; the County needs to work on an

action plan for south Orange County and the service planning area map regarding homeless; homeless encampment developed in the City of San Clemente after the riverbed closed; property owned by the City of San Clemente and the County be used to coincide with other cities to address the homeless population; all cities need to be uniform and a policy be created to address homelessness at all levels within all cities

Michelle Alexander - Oral re: City of San Clemente resident; concerns with the County's lack of leadership regarding the transient crisis in south County cities; use of unincorporated land for the homeless; U.S. 9th Circuit Court of Appeals' ruling in Martin v. City of Boise

Daisy Ramirez - Oral re: Orange County Jails Policy and Conditions Coordinator; demanded justice for recent deaths in Orange County jails including Anthony Aceves and Shakira Kelly; issues in County jail system stem from culture and history of negligence and misconduct; County has failed to access diversion options and allocate adequate funding to mental health care options outside the County jail system

Brigitte - Oral re: Board approval of Grand Jury report regarding investigation of deaths in jails; criminal cover-up and whitewash, real estate and tax fraud

Cecilia Iglesias - Oral re: Santa Ana resident and Councilmember representing Ward 6; concerns with the location of shelter being developed in the City of Santa Ana; only south County city proposing to provide a shelter is the City of Laguna Beach; invited everyone to walk the streets of the City of Santa to view the conditions residents are forced to live in

Charles Schmidt - Oral re: Resident of the City of Santa Ana; L Street shelter; requested an update of when community outreach meetings will be held regarding the L Street shelter

Bryan Kaye - Oral re: Loss of family member and pain experienced when losing a loved one; providing opportunity to individuals to succeed
