Gary Webb - Oral re: Civic Center Parking for County employees now based on position not County seniority; requested additional accessible parking spaces for employees with disabilities at the County Administration South Building

[Brigitte - Oral re: Anthony Aceves and deaths of inmates under Sheriff custody; cover-up by Grand Jury](#)

Ilya Tseglin - Oral re: Larry Landauer of Orange County Regional Center and financial profiteering; pursue justice, violation of rules of law and the County should support the constitution; Public Defender and Judges

Res 47 - Oral re: Supervisor Wagner quoted in newspaper stating he was unaware of the problem with homeless in the sober living community; Costa Mesa petition regarding sober living homes.

Robert Tseglin - Oral re: His brother Nate placed in group homes and was released by Writ of Habeas Corpus; constitutional violations and petition filed to remove conservatorship; physical and psychotropic abuse; experts testified autistic persons should not be placed on psychotropic drugs; cover-up of mental, psychotropic and physical abuse; perjury, fraud and Public Defender.

Venancio Chavez - Oral re: Delinquency and crimes in his neighborhood; homeless moved from Civic Center to nearby neighborhoods and vandalize, urinate in public, etc.; asked what can be done to ensure this doesn't happen in his neighborhood; wife was attacked by a homeless person who thought he was a dog; the safety of residents is not a priority for the City of Santa Ana; needs representation at meetings to

translate his comments from Spanish to English.

Lewis Adame - Oral re: Crimes, drugs, shooting and violence is commonplace; stop blaming crime and debt on immigrants and homeless individuals.

Lou Noble - Oral re: Homelessness and mental illness; eviction of the homeless from the riverbed and criminalizing the homeless; advocating for structured campgrounds for the homeless; SB2 zones should be opened for the homeless.

Cecilia Iglesias - Oral re: Santa Ana Councilmember, Ward 6; opposes construction of Yale Street homeless shelter; Frank Kim attended Santa Ana City Council Meeting on April 16, 2019 and read letter from Supervisor Do stating Yale Street construction would stop and community meetings would be held prior to any construction; requested to not dump County social problems on the City of Santa Ana; Courtyard needs to be moved to South County cities; existing shelter in the City of Santa Ana is not at capacity because homeless do not have roots within the City of Santa Ana.

Chris Schmidt - Oral re: Requested an update regarding the Yale Street shelter and for the County to take the lead on the community outreach meetings regarding shelters.
