PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Steve Rocco - Oral re: District Attorney Todd Spitzer went into politics for revenge, hates Americans, became a republican and Christian for political reasons

Brigitte - Oral re: Concealment of complaints from the public; Attorney General investigation into corruption in Orange County; Internal Audit report and stealing estates through forced conservatorship

Ilya Tseglin - Oral re: Has been attending meetings for his son; many people are victims of no justice in Orange County; corruption and public employees stealing money; requested meeting with Supervisors regarding corrupted judges in court

Hector B - Oral re: Vaccination efforts in Santa Ana; emails sent by community asking and begging for vaccination center; Santa Ana hit hardest by pandemic; no equity of vaccination efforts since beginning of pandemic; Board not doing enough for the community in Santa Ana and people are dying

Courtney C - Oral re: Community in Santa Ana suffering due to lack of leadership; essential workers are struggling to get a vaccine; no one advocating for Santa Ana as hardest hit city; provide grocery workers heroes pay

Bryan Kaye - Oral re: People without courage did not come to Board meetings to express themselves; forged documents; Sheriffs beat people for being mentally ill; Supervisor Wagner cannot stand up for the people giving him money; Supervisor Chaffee is putting Deputies and inmates at risk; Supervisor Do musician at Tet Parade

Kate Hernandez - Oral Re: Right to speak publicly at meetings; the Board has not provided option for the public to participate by call in or other electronic means and continues to require speakers to either appear in person or submit comments via email; Board does not enforce mask mandate or sanitize podium between speakers; suppression of public participation at Board Meetings; County has the technology to adopt a format for people to call in or participate electronically

Aristotle - Oral Re: Not OK for the Board to ignore the populations suffering poverty and hunger in this

criminally corrupt county; not OK to spend money on airport when people are suffering; public comments at board meetings

Pat Davis - Oral Re: Office of the Dead Memorial for the homeless held via Zoom at Saint Phillip Benizi's church in Fullerton; names of persons living on the streets who have died in Orange County during the month of January 2021

Felicity Figueroa - Oral Re: Homeless people with mental illness do not need funding spent on a mental health jail and instead should be spent on mental health services such as Be Well; Sheriff deputies don't want to be mental health clinicians but will be if the Musick Jail expansion is allowed to proceed; law enforcement officers attempt to 'help' people with mental issues often wind up dead
