Ilya Tseglin - Oral re: Orange County courts and pleading for his son's life for six years; American constitution and rule of law; Son Nate Tseglin is the grandson of Holocaust survivor and being placed in group home is like being placed in concentration camp; Public money stolen by criminals like Larry Landauer, judges, Public Defender, Social Services

Robert Tseglin - Oral re: Nate Tseglin probate case; removed from home and placed in group homes and released to home for six years until Irvine Police removed him; psychotropic drugs causing seizures; concealing medical records

Lou Noble - Oral re: Nate Tseglin and Board's inability to help him; mental health issues and placements in group homes; Shelters do not work unless people are treated humanely and offered transitions to homes and jobs

Bryan Kaye - Oral re: District Attorney; the definitions of the words intelligence, ignorance and stupid; round up is not safe; mental health medication Paxil; Kelly Thomas and Ron Thomas; empty jail beds; HIPPA violations and threatening to kill people for being mentally ill

Ana Ramirez - Oral re: Truth Act Forum and would like to confirm the time and place; other counties have already held their forums
