Brigitte - Oral re: Ilya Tseglin and public comments at board meetings; Public offender is under County jurisdiction; Nate Tseglin being medically kidnapped; deaths in custody; damage to the public trust

Name not provided - Oral re: Death of Kurt Reinhold; deputies were back on the job days afterward; houselessness and blackness means zero accountability for police; District Attorney also to blame; reopen case of David Sullivan

Humberto Guizar - Oral Re: Attorney with Justice X legal group dedicated to addressing systemic inequality; represents family of David Sullivan shot by Buena Park Police; District Attorney ruled shooting justified; District Attorney system is a fraud

Christian Contreras - Oral re: Member of Justice X legal group; police shooting death of David Sullivan; reopen the investigation; Police Officers Standards and Training

Deanna Sullivan - Oral re: Mother of David Sullivan who says David was helping his grandparents, working two jobs, played musical instruments; and was a loyal friend before he was murdered by Buena Park police; wants District Attorney to reopen investigation

Kent Henderson - Oral re: Death of David Sullivan at the hands of police; watch the video because David was unarmed, didn't have anything in his hands and was not reaching for a gun; there have been no prosecutions of police officers in 35 years

Carlos Montes - Oral re: Need public education and police reform; provide trauma support to families; requesting District Attorney reopen case of David Sullivan; Jackie Casey in pocket of police unions

Katie N. - Oral re: Agrees with the attorneys and family of David Sullivan to reopen the case; global civil rights movement right now; black man murdered by police

Name not provided - Oral re: Jail killer cops; do something to stop police brutality; focus on community resources; deaths of David Sullivan, Kelly Thomas and Kurt Reinhold are proof of police brutality against houseless people

Name not provided - Oral re: Lethal force used by officers against the houseless; houseless population is growing as a result pandemic

Ilya Tseglin - Oral re: Attorneys for David Sullivan said what he has been trying to say for nine years coming to the board meetings to save life of innocent son; Board knows the court is a house of lies and corrupted judges; Board has control of Public Defender

Robert Tseglin - Oral re: Probate Case of Nate Tseglin; kidnapped and placed in group home; allegations of abuse are covered up; Public Defender is supposed to defend people; conservatee protections

Sylvia N. - Oral re: Attended September 26th march for equality which was a peaceful demonstration to bring awareness to systemic injustice and police brutality; counter-protesters surrounded the peaceful protesters and police did nothing to stop them; reopen case of David Sullivan

Bryan Kaye - Oral re: Agenda item placement and changes to public comments; deaths of inmates in Sheriff custody and invested in terrifying people and tearing families apart

Sam Sullivan - Oral re: Sister of David Sullivan who was murdered by police; wants District Attorney to reopen investigation and take action against the police who shot her brother

Karen H. - Oral re: Death of Kurt Reinhold; Sheriff comments about reserving judgement; police killing has to stop; Jaywalking while homeless should not get you killed in Orange County; hold killer cops accountable

Name no provided - Oral re: KTLA article regarding Tatiana Turner and incident at peaceful protests

where counter-protesters were threatening; no statement about Jamie Mulford; Sheriff and District Attorney are guilty of collective hubris

Lorie S. - Oral re: Christopher Eisinger killed by police putting their weight on him resulting in five skull fractures and broke his eye socket; brutality by Anaheim police; reopen case of both David Sullivan and Kurt Reinhold

Douglas Chapman - Oral re: Requests waiver of the increased dog license fee for owning non-spayed pets when they are unable to be spayed due to health conditions that make surgery too dangerous.
