David Duran - Oral re: FY 2020-21 Budget is greater than prior fiscal year and Supervisors continue to maliciously allow homeless to die on the streets; homeless deaths in 2020 are on track to double last year's deaths and Supervisors and CEO remain blind to the needs of homeless and those suffering abject poverty
