PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Cheryl Fink - Oral re: Cancel Neal Kelley's consulting contract due to conflict of interest of his position as Chairman on the committee for safe and secure election

Freedom - Oral re: Asked how many supervisors lived in Santa Ana; if medical and mental health services are being provided to homeless it is not evident on the street; mid-term election and addressing voter fraud; special consideration for homeless with COVID-19 at hotels

Carolyn - Oral re: Loss of faith in the election system; machines are not certified and vulnerable to hackers and manipulation and are connected to the internet which makes them vulnerable to fraud

Joette - Oral re: Does not consent to use of machines or ballot boxes in elections, should return to single day voting on paper ballots in person, certification of election where there are more votes than voters

Ann - Oral re: Watch "True the Vote" or "The Pit" about fraudulent elections and "The Moment of Truth" by Mike Lindell that exposes how machines are hackable; COVID was a plan-demic and emergency use authorization has ended; cannot determine what is in the COVID vaccines because emergency use authorization does not require disclosure of what is contained in the vaccine; no jobs for refugees; shelters and services should only be provided to US citizens

Brigitte - Oral re: Submitted document regarding coverup of Klubnikin case proving County Counsel illegally removed a deed from a trust and covered it up to sell property; court actions should be overturned

Bryant Rumbaugh - Oral re: Cannot solve problems without discovering root cause; increase in mental health cases; build a society where people are not isolated and alienated; solutions are needed because Country has become destabilized

Todd Martin - Oral re: Thanked supervisors for their service to the County; believes elections are no longer trustworthy; Board needs to take election process seriously and restore faith in elections; core of democracy is the right to vote; without it we are left with minority rule; selfishness is at the heart of cheaters

Kate - Oral re: US Constitution gives one person one vote; voter fraud in Orange County; requested no machines, no ballot boxes, and one day of voting with same day results; require voter ID, outlaw ballot harvesting and clean up voter rolls; end state of emergency

Susan - Oral re: Lost faith in elections; three experts showed how machines were hackable; machines are vulnerable to manipulation; requested no drop boxes and ensure chain of custody is maintained; watch documentary 2000 mules; eliminate ballot harvesting

Tony Chargualaf - Oral re: Difficulty using housing vouchers; AB143 and SB1152; housing case managers provide vouchers that do not accept subsidized housing vouchers; need vouchers that accept low income vouchers

Carolyn - Oral re: Everyone should agree that election integrity is critical to maintaining our democracy; neither red nor blue trust our outcomes; follow the example of European democracies with one day voting and results the same day

Dawn - Oral re: Board approved Agenda item from 9/25/20, #25 adopting Resolution 20-143 retroactively approving the federalization of Orange County elections without the consent of the people and provided Registrar of Voters authority to modify a contract without further action of the Board; Board abdicated their responsibility; constitutional violations; e-voting machines not tested to standards
