PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Steve Rocco - Oral re: Wrote book regarding false evidence and perjured testimony; newspaper articles about Steve Rocco are all lies; no difference between District Attorney and Public Defender, they all fix cases and murder people; Scott Powers and Scott Decrai

Robert Tseglin - Oral re: Nate Tseglin separated from family confined in group home; collusion between Regional Center to remove conservatorship and conceal records; psychotropic and physical abuse; Public Defender and Adult Protective Services do not protect conservatee; lack of decency and oversight of the offices involved; ongoing obstruction of justice; unlicensed group home

Ilya Tseglin - Oral re: Freedom and value of life; requested appointment to meet with Board members to provide facts and proof to support allegations against Regional Center and Adult Protective Services who are profiteering at expense of innocent people

Brian Kaye - Oral re: Rode bike in honor of Cameraman; Todd Spitzer posted pictures wearing a mask before COVID; Board had allowed drug testing labs create their own levels/standards of pass or fail; recording in court by Deputy Sheriff; the Cameraman wants a healthy future and healthy community

Cynthia Ashley - Oral re: Article published regarding death of homeless; bond measure on ballot to fund housing first and commit to discretionary funding to end homeless

Pastor Dennis Kriz - Oral re: Families living in mobile homes, housing affordability is cause of homelessness in Orange County; urged the Board to commit funds to end homeless through Housing First model; options for raising money necessary to build affordable housing units without relying on state or federal funding

Rona Smyth - Oral re: Put a bond measure on the ballot to support the building of affordable and permanent supportive housing

Sheena Innocente - Oral re: Housing affordability is the primary driver of homelessness; options for raising money necessary to build affordable housing units without relying on state or federal funding; commit funds to end homeless through Housing First model

Felicity Figueroa - Oral re: Unhoused community members suffer mental health illnesses and need housing rather than mental health jail; death of Kurt Reinhold; build specialized mental health clinics instead of jail expansion

Thomas Fielder - Oral re: White paper on housing affordability crisis in Orange County; call to action to place a bond measure on the ballot to support housing first initiative; bond measure would close the funding gap needed to build the 2700 permanent supportive housing units needed

Callie Rutter - Oral re: Housing affordability is the primary driver of homelessness; put a bond measure

on the ballot to fund Housing First model; commit funds to end homelessness

Michelle Antennesse - Oral re: Housing affordability is the primary driver of homelessness; place a bond measure on the ballot to support housing first model and end homelessness in Orange County

Jacky Tran - Oral re: Supports needs of homelessness in Orange County; Project Roomkey helped friend; provide more funding for affordable and permanent supportive housing; place a bond measure on the ballot to support housing first model and end homelessness in Orange County

Karenita Hernandez - Oral Re: Member of Noise of OC; asks for apology for comments made at prior meeting belittling work of journalists
