Felicity Figueroa - Comments read by County Counsel: Unhoused members of the community struggle with some form of mental illness and need stable home with wrap-around services; opposes James A. Musick expansion as mental health jail; use money to develop treatment facilities or more stable housing environments so community members won't continue to be criminalized for living on the streets
