Kate - Oral Re: Played audio of San Joaquin County Sheriff's concerns about potential vulnerabilities in California's voter registration system; Board has not cleaned up voter rolls in Orange County; requested the Voters Choice Act be agendaized on the next agenda; requested one day voting on paper ballots, paper poll books and precincts near her home
