Carol Graves - Oral Re: Jurisdiction of the horses and animal cruelty by the Orange County Fairgrounds CEO, Michelle Richards and her staff at the OC Fairgrounds; horses have not been able to exercise which has led to dangerous situation for the horses, handlers and riders; advocate for horses because they helped her child who is autistic; horses should not be pawns in a contract dispute and receive exercise per codes and regulations of stalled animals; requested Board intervene, change the situation and have safety restored for horses, children and handlers

Paul Hyek - Oral Re: Recycling symbol displayed on some products but not others; Ventura County requires eBike vendors to have a M1 license by the Department of Motors Vehicles and cannot be purchased by anyone under the age of 18

Richard Larsen - Oral Re: Concerns with those advocates against Orange County's election system are without merit; recommended not changing Orange County's voting system
